Success Measure E-1

Percent of Kent County electric utility accounts located in ZIP=2 codes with a 12-month average shut-off rate below 1%

Indicator E-1.1

Percent of state government business days in which utility assistance was available

Indicator E-1.2

Percent of eligible residents (150% of poverty or less) receiving any subsidy in the course of the year

Indicator E-1.3

Percent of Kent County households spending no more than 2% of their local geography's median household income on electric utility service

Success Measure E-2

Percent of Kent County households consuming per-capita energy (kWh) at least 5% below baseline 5-year Michigan state average per-capita consumption

Indicator E-2.1

Percent of Kent County residents who participated in an energy efficiency education program in the past 12 months
